### Saturday, October 13th and Sunday, October 14th (1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.)

**4-Wheeling Jeep Adventure** – Four-wheeling is the perfect way to see the real Sonoran Desert. Guests will be picked up at the resort's front drive in open-air jeep scramblers and then head for the base of the Tortolita Mountains. From the desert floor to the majestic mountains, experienced driver guides who are "outdoor" people knowledgeable in the field of native flora and fauna will lead the tour. The adventure itself will take you through some of the most beautiful desert regions in all of Arizona. The desert is full of wildlife and the drivers are quick to point out any deer, jackrabbits, javelina or other wildlife that might cross your path. You will enjoy a botanical nature walk that will help you gain an appreciation of the most lush desert in the world and our live critter demonstration will give you an upclose and personal look at some of the desert's inhabitants. Authenticity is stressed. **Cost: \$89.00 per person**

### Saturday, October 13th and Sunday, October 14th (1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.)

**Arizona Sonora Desert Museum** – The Arizona Sonora Desert Museum is one of Tucson's best loved desert treasures. Noted as "the most distinctive zoo in the United States," it is a combination zoological park and botanical garden. It's a delightful place to view and enjoy all the area's desert wonders – animal, plant, reptile and insect. The Arizona Sonora Desert Museum is not only a world-renowned zoo but a natural history museum and botanical garden, all in one place! Exhibits re-create the natural landscape of the Sonoran Desert Region so realistically you find yourself eye-to-eye with mountain lions, prairie dogs, Gila monsters, and more. Within the Museum grounds, you will see more than 300 animal species and 1,200 kinds of plants. Also included in the exhibits are a walk-in aviary (with a separate facility for hummingbirds). A life-underground-exhibit simulates a cave. Actual roots are woven into the natural-looking concrete banks to add authenticity. There are almost 2 miles of paths traversing 21 acres of beautiful desert. Guests will depart from the resort's front drive with our professional tour guide. **Cost: \$59.00 per person**

### Saturday, October 13th and Monday, October 15th (1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.)

**Horseback Trail Ride** – You're in cowboy country! Do as the cowboys do, ride through desert foothills, cross washes, and get a whole new view of the Sonoran Desert. Capable wranglers will lead you along trails pointing out the wildlife and desert landscape. So don your jeans and take a trail ride Arizona-style. Guests will be picked up on the resort's front drive and transferred to the stables, then matched up with their horses based on riding experience. **Cost: \$65.00 per person / Note: There is a 230 pound weight limit for this event.**

### Sunday, October 14th (1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.) and Tuesday, October 16th (11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.)

**Tubac Artist Colony Tour** – Forty-five miles south of Tucson, Tubac was at one time the site of a Spanish presidio built to protect nearby missions and settlements from Indian attack. Today, it's the town "where art and history meet." Artists and crafts people live and work in Tubac and offer the visitor prints, poetry, jewelry, batiks and paintings. History buffs will love to tour the historic Tubac Presidio State Park and Museum. Art buffs will enjoy the Tubac center of the arts which features free performances and changing exhibits of visual art. **Cost: \$45.00 per person**

### Monday, October 15th (1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.)

**Sabino Canyon** - Twelve thousand years ago, Columbian mammoth roamed here. About 1200 A.D., irrigation dams were placed in the creek by Hohokam Indians. In the 1870's, pony soldiers from Fort Lowell enjoyed horseback excursions to the "ol' swimmin' hole" still in use today. In the 1930's, civilian conservation groups built bridges and cut hiking trails 3.8 miles into the Santa Catalina Mountains. Wildlife and fauna flourish in this preserve. An open-air, outdoor motorized tram gets you up close and makes several stops for guests to take in the panoramic views – cameras are a must. En route from Sabino Canyon, we will visit DeGrazia's Gallery in the Sun. The DeGrazia Gallery, designed by the artist himself, consists of a group of low slung adobes exhibiting his earliest and latest works. Within the museum, there are six galleries of paintings and displays. Each gallery has a different collection. You will immediately recognize the works of DeGrazia as he is the most reproduced artist in the world. The gift shop is open for browsing and shopping. Guests will depart from the resort's front drive with our professional tour guide. **Cost: \$42.00 per person**
