The show has received numerous awards for its coverage of issues relating to politics and economics. Previously, Mr. Hewitt was the host of "Searching for God in America," an eight-part series that premiered on PBS in July 1996.

Mr. Hewitt has been a featured speaker for organizations around the nation. His speaking engagements have included the Industry Manufacturer's Council, American Association of Planners, League of California Cities, Richard Nixon Library, Investment Company Institute, the Young Presidents' Organization and Legatus.
