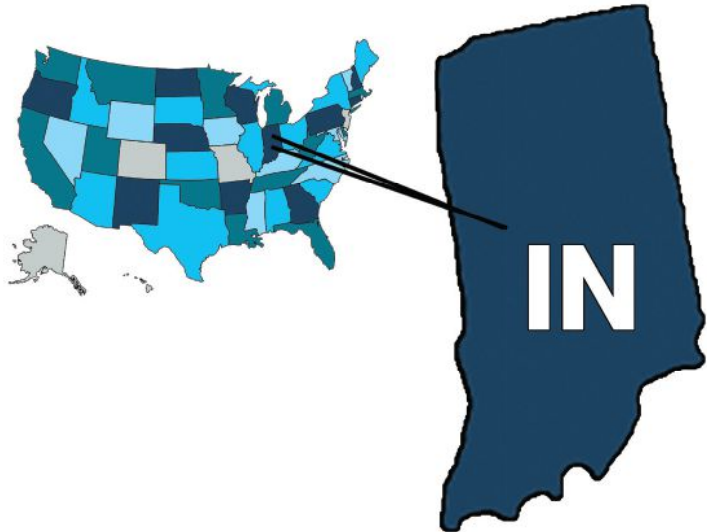

- Manufacturing is Indiana's largest industry.
- Manufacturing is Indiana's largest GDP producer.
- Manufacturing is the largest contributor to Indiana's economic output and employment.

INDIANA MANUFACTURING ACCOUNTS FOR

Manufacturing Is Productivity

- **26.56%** of the Indiana total output (GDP)

Manufacturing Builds Businesses

- **6,942** manufacturing establishments are in the state of Indiana.

Manufacturing Creates Jobs

- **Jobs: 17.51%** of all Indiana employees are in the manufacturing sector. (546,000 employees)

Manufacturing Earns Export Dollars

- **Indiana manufactured goods exports** were valued at \$40.34 Billion.

Manufacturing Drives Economies

- Indiana's output generated by its manufacturing sector is worth more than \$150 billion a year to Indiana's economy.

- Manufacturing jobs pay on average 36% more than the average jobs in Indiana. *(according to NAM.org)*
- At the beginning of 2022, Indiana had more than 83,000 unfilled manufacturing positions.
