• 12,138 manufacturing establishments in the state of Pennsylvania.

Manufacturing Creates Jobs

- 9.53% of all Pennslyvania employees are in the manufacturing sector. (562,700 employees)
- On average, each manufacturing job created provides 2.5 additional jobs in Pennslyvania.
- Manufacturing jobs pay on average 33% more than the average job in Pennsylvania.
- These higher paying jobs provide workers more than just higher wages; 90% of manufacturing workers have medical benefits, along with 78% of workers receiving retirement contributions from their employers.
